WHO WE ARE

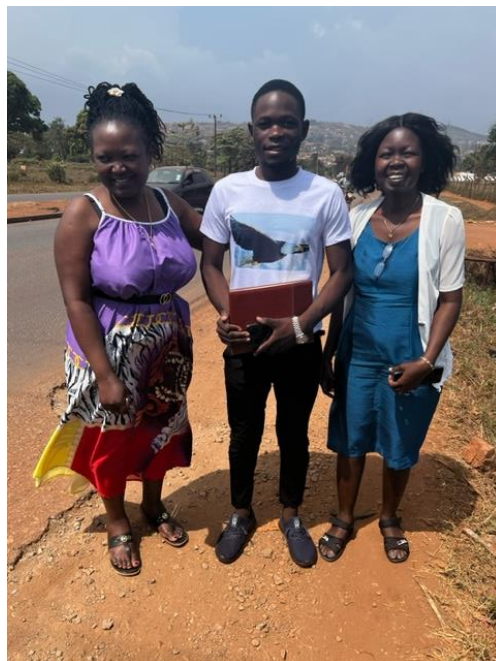
